Maglev Exhibition Center



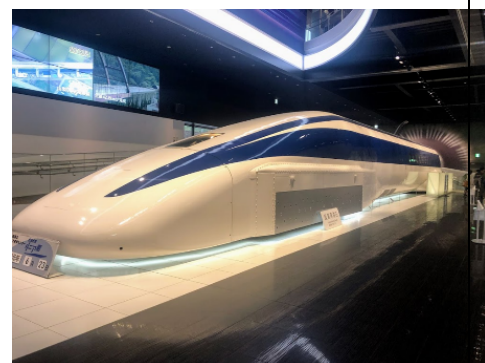
Do you know Maglev train? Maglev train is the train which can run more than 500km/h. Moreover it's eco-friendly. This center opened in conjunction with the commencement of testing at the Yamanashi Maglev Test Track. You can not only learn about the history and contracture of maglev train but also feel massive speed of the future train! Why don't you come and feel the future transportation.

- **Open** : 9:00~17:00

(You can't enter after 16:30.)

- **Closed day**: every Monday

(It sometimes changes because of holidays. Please check their homepage.)



- **Admission fee**

Adult: 420yen / High school student: 310yen

Junior high school and elementary school student: 200yen

Preschooler: Free

- **Access**

You can come this center by both car and public transportation.

- If you come from Tokyo or Kofu by public transportation...

You get off the train at Otsuki station and get on the buses which go to the center.

(Otsuki→the center: 15min / 300yen)

- If you come from Kawaguchi-ko station or Fujisan station by public transportation...

You get off the train at Kasei station and get on the buses which go to the center or walk for 20 min.

(Kasei→the center: 5min / 220yen)
