




He loves traveling and often visit many prefectures in Japan. Actually, he has visited thirty-one prefectures. At that time, he watches situations of overtourism.



In these days, many people focus on making restriction, but he does not. He does focus on telling attraction of local areas. the reason why he wants people to know the attraction of local areas is for dispersing tourists. If the number of tourists disperse, famous areas' environment will be comfortable and safe and local economy will grow. That's why, when he starts to work at travel company, he will try to encourage local tourism.

To make tourism better...

Except for the number of tourists, the manner of tourists is a big problem. Many tourists tend to break the rules like traffic rules, photo ones, and trash rules because they are likely to concentrate on buildings, nature, and food. So, how we teach them rules or manners is important things. In the interview, he mentioned two ways.

1, Oral explanation

This is the most basic ways. When we encounter people who break rules, we call them and warn their bad thing. At first glance, there is no problem, but we have to select words very carefully. For example, if we say “Don’t~”, they feel disgust. So, we have to use nice words like “Please~”. But this is a difficult way because Japanese people are shy. They tend to hesitate to call people. For keeping the environment safe and clean, don’t be shy!

2, Photo, Pictogram

John thinks this is the most effective way since we can understand those meaning without any languages. So, people don’t have to talk with stranger, it is not cost everyone and this way match with Japanese people character. Another reason is keeping spots traditional. Some sightseeing spots care about exterior. Choosing materials leads to maintain looks.
